### **Ward Forum Meeting**

Sergeant Kiran Patel attended the Councillors Ward Forum Meeting at Naseby Youth Centre on Monday 17 March. A number of concerns were raised by residents including parking and flytipping.

The Council are the lead agency to deal with flytipping and we have supported their proactive team in seizing vehicles linked to flytipping.

We carry out regular policing operations to deal with inappropriate parking where we will issue fines and/or seize vehicles for obstructing the public highway. This can also be reported directly via [National Dash Cam Safety Portal | Nextbase UK](#).

We also have plans in place for regular speed enforcement activities within the local area. Officers are already engaged with community groups, such as the Ward End Residents Group where community SpeedWatch Operations are being carried out.

We have been working with @BhamCityCouncil parking enforcement team to ensure that those who park inappropriately get tickets or have their vehicles seized.

### Arrests - 18 people were arrested by our officers in March.

These include offences for rape, recall to prison, fail to appear, theft from motor vehicle, shoplifting, assault and more! Here are some of our successful arrests and outcomes...

A female who was arrested for **x3 theft from motor vehicle offences and recall to prison** was charged and remanded. She was found guilty at court and sent to prison!

Two youths who caused **damage to a bus on Washwood Heath Road** were identified and arrested. One of the males admitted the offence and was given a community resolution with specific conditions.

A male was arrested on Alum Rock Road for **possession of an offensive weapon** after he threatened a shop worker.

A female was arrested for **four shoplifting offences on the Alum Rock Road** and was given a conditional caution.

A female was arrested for **drunk in charge of a motor vehicle on Gumbleberrys Close** and was charged for failing to provide a specimen of breath.

A male was identified **arrested by plain clothes officers** after we had reports of threats and abuse towards School children in Bordesley Green.

We are pleased to say that Chaand Raat and Eid patrols were successful. The policing operation included neighbourhood officers working until 4am with support from additional and specialist resources such as drones, dogs and traffic officers.

We are grateful for the support that we received from Radio Aap Ki Awaaz and the Alum Rock Traders Association, who joined officers on patrol and were pleased to have community/Cllrs join our briefings.
